Nine years later in *Olmstead*, the Supreme Court held that "under Title II of the ADA, States are required to provide community-based treatment for persons with mental disabilities when the State's treatment professionals determine that such placement is appropriate, the affected persons do not oppose such treatment, and the placement can be reasonably accommodated. Some of the services that HCBS individuals are able to receive are case management; habilitation which may include certain pre-vocational, supportive employment and certain special educational services; personal care and respite services; adult day care and adult day health services; day treatment or other partial hospitalization services; psychosocial rehabilitation services and clinic services for individuals with chronic mental illness; home delivered meals; home health aides; and homemaker services.
