The Polish people were ready for a fight even though they were outnumbered by the Germans and they were very suspicious of the Soviet Union. In The Gulag Archipelago , Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn laments that he and his fellow prisoners did not resist when they had the chance: And how we burned in the camps later, thinking: What would things have been like if every Security operative, when he went out at night to make an arrest, had been uncertain whether he would return alive and had to say good-bye to his family? The Western Allies tried to assist through aerial supply, but that was ineffective and the Home Army surrendered on October 2, Meanwhile on September 27, , the Warsaw garrison of , troops surrendered to the Germans. The Germans were indiscriminate in their violence during the advance into Poland. It was a time of joyous excitement which words can but tamely describe. A new world had opened upon me. Sooner or later, one or the other will give. It is a country that Filipinos can learn from as our nation grapples with its worst threat from a foreign power since the end of the Second World War. A total of , Polish soldiers, airmen, and sailors managed to escape through Romania and elsewhere. Forty thousands Polish civilians were killed in the siege of the capital. Here in the US, many people, instead of seeing jury service as a quintessential civic duty , regard the obligation with impatience, exasperation and contempt. Or what about the Black Maria sitting out there on the street with one lonely chauffeurâ€™”what if it had been driven off or its tires spiked? Free people should recognize they have been blessed with a rare gift. Tiananmen Square was only the first episode. Hong Kong is a mature, sophisticated society, filled with free people capable of self-rule. The new generation is educated and has travelled abroad. I grieve for the people of China, who are living in an increasingly totalitarian state, and especially the millions who have been incarcerated in the re-education camps of Xinjiang. In December , by an act of the Polish parliament, democracy was restored in Poland. In occupied Poland, Polish Jews staged an uprising at the Warsaw ghetto in that was brutally crushed by the Germans.
